

Student Evangelist Scholarship



QUALIFICATIONS

The Georgia-Cumberland Conference (GCC) Student Evangelist Scholarship will provide up to \$2,500 in scholarships for students who have preached full, seventeen (17) night evangelistic meetings, either overseas or within GCC, within these parameters:

1. Overseas Evangelism – \$1,000 to each qualifying student (see below), \$500 coming from the conference and \$500 from the participating school (also identified below). These are typically coordinated by ShareHim, though other sponsoring organizations will be considered upon request.
2. Evangelism within the GCC – \$1,500 to each qualifying student, \$750 coming from the conference and \$750 from the participating school. These would be arranged in collaboration with the your local pastor and Cynthia Gettys, Vice President for Education (cgettys@gccsda.org).
3. Qualifying Students – To be considered, a student must:
 - a. Hold membership in one of the GCC churches and be attending one of the following GCC academies:
 - i. Atlanta Adventist Academy
 - ii. Collegedale Academy
 - iii. Georgia-Cumberland Academy
 - b. Return to school following the evangelistic series to one of the schools identified above or to Southern Adventist University.
 - c. Apply through the Cynthia Gettys, Vice President for Education (cgettys@gccsda.org).
 - d. Participate in training and orientation, provided by GCC and the coordinating organization (if overseas).
 - e. Preach the entire evangelistic series.
 - f. Report on the experience once completed to our GCC constituency through personal appearances, print and electronic media, as negotiated.
 - g. Submit a one-page written report of the evangelistic series event and a photo of the presenter.
4. Participating Schools – The following partner schools are participating in the Student Evangelism Scholarship:
 - a. Atlanta Adventist Academy
 - b. Collegedale Academy
 - c. Georgia-Cumberland Academy
 - d. Southern Adventist University
5. A maximum of \$10,000 per year will be allocated from GCC for this initiative. Applicants will be considered as long as funds are available.
